Changes in Dues Collection for 2014

The association dues collection process is about is about to be streamlined. It's been the practice to simply make your dues payment to the EHHA treasurer on May 1. Beginning in 2014, all homeowners will receive an invoice for annual dues, on or about April 1. This will give all homeowners a printed reminder that payment will be due beginning May 1. We ask that you submit that payment no later than May 31. Complete instructions for submission of dues payments will be included with the invoice.
